Thanksgiving Love Feast Carry-In November 21, 5:30 p.m.

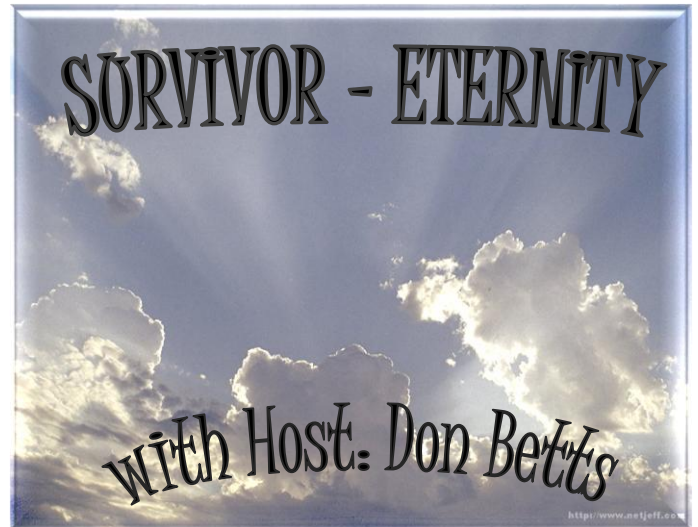
Join us for a wonderful evening celebrating this season of "Thankfulness" with great food, fellowship, Master Design performance, Christmas Carols etc...
