From the Pastor...

Happy New Year! 2012 should be a great year of growth for Crestview. We spent the major part of 2011 getting all the preliminaries and basics ready for Church Growth Strategy. 2012 is a time for putting ourselves to the task with Holy Spirit energy. The Bible says, "not by might, nor by power, but by my Spirit says the LORD of Hosts" (Zechariah). Remember, our goal is to glorify God by running 300 in Celebration Worship by CHRISTmas 2012. The greeting also continues after the service in the worship center while they are still seated, at the door to the worship center, and at the Welcome Center and foyer.
